SEQUENCE ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS

Students must take 6 to 7 hours in sequence electives.

Two courses selected from Media Studies Required Courses: MS 317, 410, 331, 264, 351, or 320.

College of Media Electives: 14-22 total hours of ADV, CINE, JOUR, MS or MDIA electives.

ONE OR TWO AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION

At least 18 hours of credit in one or two approved areas outside the College. At least three courses (9 hours) are required in each approved area. An approved College minor is acceptable in lieu of specialization.

ADVANCED HOURS REQUIREMENT

Not less than 20 hours in courses outside the College numbered 200 or above. At least 9 of the 20 hours must be in courses numbered 300 or above.
