SEQUENCE ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS

Students must take 6 to 7 hours in sequence electives. Students may NOT count MS 356, 375, or 432 as a sequence elective requirement.

Two Cinema Studies courses selected from the following categories (a max of one from each category):

Either CINE 261 OR CINE 262

One course from Non-US Cinema Course
Requirements: CINE 266, 419, 466, 470, 488, 489, 490, 492, 493, or 494.

One course from Identity, Culture and Politics
Requirements: CINE 211, 275, 365, 381, or 385.

College of Media Electives: 14-22 total hours of ADV, CINE, JOUR, MS or MDIA electives.

ONE OR TWO AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION

At least 18 hours of credit in one or two approved areas outside the College. At least three courses (9 hours) are required in each approved area. An approved College minor is acceptable in lieu of specialization.

ADVANCED HOURS REQUIREMENT

Not less than 20 hours in courses outside the College numbered 200 or above. At least 9 of the 20 hours must be in courses numbered 300 or above.
